ACCORDING TO THE DIAGNOSTIC STATISTICAL MANUAL-5 (DSM-5; 2013), MENTAL ILLNESS IS DEFINED BY THE FOUR CRITERIA

- 1. A syndrome characterized by clinically significant disturbance in an individual's cognitive, emotion regulation, or behavior.
- 2. The individual's disturbance reflects dysfunction in psychological, biological, or developmental processes associated with the dysfunction.
- 3. Characterized by distress or disability in functioning in social, occupational, or other important activities.
- 4. Socially deviant behavior and conflicts that resulted from dysfunctional behavior.
