Such posts could include relevant questions about the assignments and unit topics, on-topic responses to questions and observations, and relevant examples. <p>Deductions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Responses may not be on topic • Posts lack relevancy or engagement with the topic. • Student does not post throughout the hour. 	10

<p>Content:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Response is on-topic and original. • Response summarizes three points covered in the live seminar. • Response addresses all of the assignment questions. • Response is at least two well-developed paragraphs. <p>Deductions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Response may not be on topic or make informed references to the live seminar archive. • Response may not summarize at least three points covered in the live seminar or address the assignment questions. • Response is not two well-developed paragraphs.. <p>No credit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plagiarized responses will result in an automatic “0” for the option 2 seminar grade. 	8	8
