<p>Content :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Assignment includes a potential thesis statement, which is logical and persuasive. ● Assignment includes four annotations for sources related to the selected topic. ● Annotation identifies at least one source which addresses a challenge or misconception about the topic. ● Annotations are well-developed, coherent, and logically organized. ● Annotations include a thoughtful summary of the source's argument and purpose, assess the credibility of the source, and reflect upon the value of that source for supporting student's argument for change. ● Annotations are original, and material from sources is paraphrased in the student's own words. <p>Deductions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Assignment may be missing a thesis statement, or the thesis is not persuasive or logical. ● Does not have four annotations. ● Does not identify a challenge source ● Annotations may not be well-developed, coherent, or logically organized. ● Annotations may be missing a summary, assessment, or reflection about the source. ● Does not include a source that addresses a challenge or misconception about the topic. ● Content may not be original (relies on quotation or does not properly paraphrase sources' ideas). 	70	
<p>Sources:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Annotated bibliography includes at least four sources, which can include the following types: [book or e-book (full text version), periodical article, Internet source, audio or video source, primary source (interview, poll)]. ● Annotated bibliography includes at least one periodical or book (preferably from the KU Library) ● Sources are appropriate for an academic/formal audience. <p>Deductions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Does not have at least four sources. ● Does not include at least one periodical or ebook ● Sources may not be appropriate for an academic audience. 	10	
<p>APA (A):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Project includes a title page and follows APA 6th edition formatting requirements for title page and document layout. ● Includes complete and correctly formatted APA 6th edition citations 	10

<p>Style and mechanics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The style is appropriate to the assignment, and sentences are engaging to read as well as clear, concise, and precise. • Project is free of serious errors; grammar, punctuation, and spelling help to clarify the meaning by following accepted conventions of Standard American English. <p>Deductions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Style may not be appropriate for academic writing (slang, overly conversational language and may not follow conventions of Standard English). • Sentences may be wordy or confusing. • Project has errors in grammar, punctuation, spelling, or sentence structure. 	10
