

CMS-1500 Claim Project

Unit outcomes addressed in this Assignment:

- Identify eligibility guidelines, Medicare billing forms and procedures, different parts of Medicare, PAR and NON-PAR providers, and fraud and abuse.
- Understand requirements for Medicaid qualifications and benefits.
- Demonstrate knowledge of TRICARE eligibility, types of benefits, and completion and submission of TRICARE claims using CMS- 1500.
- Demonstrate general knowledge of Workers Compensation procedures steps for billing.

Instructions

For this Project, you will complete two CMS-1500 claim forms based on two different case studies.

Your instructor will select two case studies from your textbook, and post them, along with their page numbers, in the course Announcements section.

Complete each case based on the following criteria:

- All patients have release of information and assignment of benefits signature on file.
- All providers are participating and accept assignment.
- The group practice is the billing entity.
- ICD-10-CM and CPT codes from your current manuals are accepted.
- When entering procedures, enter the E/M code first, followed by all other codes in descending cost order.

- Use these history and exam levels to determine E/M codes:

Min = Minimal

D = Detailed

PF = Problem Focused

C = Comprehensive

EPF = Extended Problem Focused

HC = Comprehensive with High
Complexity decision making

- Use 8 digit dates for birthdates and use 6 digit dates for all other dates.
- All street names should be entered using standard postal abbreviations even if they are spelled out on the source documents. For example: Street should be St.
