 on culture and the culture of criminals? Consider the historical impact of community based
 corrections and discuss any research findings available on your state website (Note: look for
 headings titled Research and/or Publications) or from other outside sources to assess the
 effectiveness of these programs. Be sure to cite specific research.

Part B: Correctional Institutions

Describe three types of correctional institutions available for adults in your state. Be sure to identify institutions, Federal Bureau of Prisons, and private prisons based on the following designations: security level; men's and women's facilities; and public and private institutions.

In addition to fulfilling the specifics of the Assignment, you should format your presentation consistent with the following guidelines:

- Use one basic slide design and layout.
- Limit slides to between 5 and 7 lines of content.
- Use bullets for your main points.
